COVID-19 Vaccine Update 2.8.21

Hello Leslie,

Below are important updates on vaccine availability in New York and Connecticut.

STATE OF NEW YORK residents:

Governor Cuomo announced today that the residents under the age of 65 (with certain medical conditions only) may register for a COVID-19 vaccine starting next Monday, February 15th. Here is the list of medical conditions included in his announcement (all subject to change):

- Cancer (prior or current)
- Chronic kidney or liver disease
- Pulmonary disease (COPD, mod/severe asthma, Cystic Fibrosis, Pulmonary fibrosis, and other pulmonary disease related to 9/11 attacks)
- Heart Conditions (heart failure, coronary artery disease, cardiomyopathies, and hypertension)
- Immunocompromised patients (organ/blood/bone marrow transplant recipients, immune deficiencies, HIV, use of corticosteroid medications)
- Obesity—BMI (Body Mass Index) greater than 30
- Pregnancy
- Sickle cell anemia or Thalassemia
- Diabetes
- Cerebrovascular disease
- Neurologic conditions
- Intellectual and developmental disabilities

If you are a patient with the medical conditions listed above, you will need a letter from us validating that you fit these criteria...please contact the office.
